**Car Wash**-Denis spoke with the Burger King Manager. He has Sunday 4/26 & Sunday 5/3 available. We will need to do advanced ticket sales @ ShopRite and A&P 4/18/& 419. We will have a 5 gallon water bottle there for donations. We will need a couple of parents to organize and get permission from the stores to sell the tickets.
