**Vice President's Report (Denis Stypulkoski):**

**Grocery Cards**-Shop Rite and A&P have agreed to let us sell cards outside the stores. We will sell the cards on Saturday/Sundays in 4 hour blocks & every boy will be required to take a 2 hour shift. A parent or two must be there at all times. We will have a bucket for cash donations. Times will be determined after the season gets underway.

**New Fundraisers**-Ed Sommerkorn will set up Restaurant Nights with Valley Restaurant, Public House, & IHop. Denis spoke with a parent from Randolph HS Ice Hockey team. They run 2 car washes (fall/spring). Advance tickets are sold outside the supermarkets (\$5/ticket) and players are required to sell 4 tickets each. - Replacement jerseys were ordered through Mennen. They need to be ordered earlier next year.
- There are not enough blue helmets for both Varsity & JV so only Varsity will be required to have the blue helmet. Coach will check with Aspen.
- Gail Halko will look into ordering decals.
- Medical forms must be submitted to the nurse so that players can be cleared prior to tryouts on 11/15 @ 10 am.

**Treasurer's Report (Dave Kavanaugh):**

- Gave \$12,578 ice deposit witch leaves a balance of \$19,426 excluding credits for supermarket cards.
- The next installment for dues is due at the Face Off Dinner on 11/20 and the final installment is due 12/1/08. See Dave to find out what your credits are. (One player has over \$400 in supermarket credits!). Please put your child's first and last name on all checks.

**New Business:**

- Coach was asked about getting a fan bus for some of the games. He will look into it.
- Coach was asked about getting the players bused to Chill Out (one way only) for the after school practices. Eight parents in attendance indicated that they would not be able to get their children to the practices due to the early times. Possibilities discussed were carpooling (limited due to bags & bags would have to be dropped off at school in the morning by parents) & booster club or only parents in need to pay for a bus. The Coach will check on the availability and cost.
