Treasurer's Report (Dave Kavanaugh):

We are in good shape with deposits. There are only a few players that have not paid. The full balance is due before the season starts, 12/1, in order for players to participate. You can start making payments now or pay your full balance at one time. Extenuating circumstances will be considered if an extended payment plan is needed.

Coach's Report: (Coach Jacobsen)

Tryouts begin 11/15. Boys will be given a schedule. He met with the boys last week. He will give the boys paperwork that they must complete and will be checking their grades. A Parent/Player Hand Book will also be given out. There have been some changes in the league. The schedule will not be handed out until it is finalized, but the first Varsity Game is 12/5 and the first JV game will be 12/4. All parents, especially parent of new players, should attend the next meeting to get information about the team, practices, games, policies, etc.
