Coach Jacobsen

Coach wants the players to be responsible and to communicate with him, not the parents
The coaching staff, as of now, was not affected by the budget
We do not anticipate activity fess at this time, especially for ice hockey

If buses are not going to be provided for practices then practice times will not be immediately after school
Coach and AD are going to Chill Out tomorrow to discuss ice time for next year
Coach is considering running a clinic for younger kids to promote the program

Treasurers Report

There will be an increase in Club expenses for next year. The school picked up a portion of the ice time this past season
There is approximately \$22,000 in reserve
Rebate from last year's fund raising efforts which will be applied to returning players 2010-2011 tuition is \$215.
Senior parents were sent rebate checks
Ice time will be around \$300/hour

Fundraising

We need to generate \$12,500 in fundraising for next year. After consideration of many ideas discussed at previous meetings, the fundraising committee narrowed it down to the car wash and a car raffle. In order to have the car raffle, we must have commitment from the parents. Kevil Chevrolet lent us the car which we would raffle off to bring to this meeting and it is parked outside. A CPA would certify the tickets. The winning ticket would be drawn at the face off. We will sell 1000 tickets maximum. If we are short in sales, Kevil will work with us, and if it is a flop, we will refund the ticket sales. Each family needs to sell 10 tickets to break even. We are in the process of getting approval from the state and the township for this raffle. We would bring the car to car shows, the A&P, the car wash, etc to sell tickets. Kurt Peirson will donate a TV as a second prize. Debbie Peirson will order banners. All parents will get numbered books of tickets to sell. A sign promoting the sale will be put on the Fischer's property. Accepting credit cards was discussed. A motion was made by Tricia Williams and seconded by Blane Harrison to run a car raffle to raise funds for the Club. A vote was taken and all those present were in favor. Dave DiVincentis will call the members not present.

The car wash will be held the Saturday after Labor Day, 9/18 in the A&P parking lot adjacent to Burger King. Tickets will be sold in advance. Fran Driscoll will chair again.

Replacement Jerseys-

Bill delturrondo got prices for the replacement jerseys and will take care of ordering them.

The next meeting will be held in September with exact date to be determined.

A motion to adjourn was made by Tricia Williams and seconded by Fran Driscoll at 9:00 PM.
