Dave was not able to attend. Jeanine Marino reported a balance of \$15,000 in an interest bearing money market account and \$7,400 in a checking account for a total of \$22,400.

Coach's Report: (Coach Jacobsen)

Coach's looking forward to a productive year. He highly recommends and encourages parents to attend monthly meetings to be involved and informed of what is going on with the Club. He has not been able to speak with Chill Out due to his baseball commitment to determine if Summer Hockey will be one time per week or just one week. He will inform us by email when arrangements have been made. The boys are expected in the weight room. There will be lifting over the summer and in the fall prior to the start of the season. Incoming freshman are expected to attend. Coach Dell gives the boys hockey specific training. Other teams lift and our boys must also to stay competitive. Players, including incoming, were asked to stand and introduce themselves.

Questions-How many players are expected for next year? Around 33.

- Will there be a JV team? Yes, they will play in a 13 game league at Aspen.
- When is the first payment due? A \$250 deposit fee is due for players in September. The player fee for the year depends on the cost of ice among other things. We will have more information in September.
- Is fee refundable? The deposit is refundable if the player decides not to play or does not make the team.

Coaches Apparel-Coach Jacobsen requested a new Boat House Jacket for himself and warm up suits for all coaches to wear to games. Gail Halko brought up the fact that we need to keep our costs down considering the economic times and that our money might be put to better use to benefit the players or to reduce the player fee.
