Coach asked if the 6 stat girls can be invited to the banquet since they have been very consistent this year. We will also get them a small thank you gift.

**Beef Steak-**Keith Schultis reported that he met with Debbie Peirson and Pam Fischer last week and decided not to hold the Beef Steak. After discussion it was decided not to have a spring fundraiser, but to consider an event for the fall to start off the season, possibly at the Face Off Dinner. Some ideas were a Wine Tasting, Taste of the Town, or a Tricky Tray/Comedian at the Face Off. Montville parents are required to buy two tables at \$500/table. Pam will get more information on how Montville arranges this event. This event pays the player fees. Keith's son is graduating and Pam is not able to chair the event, but will help. A chairperson is needed.

**Treasurer's Report (Dave Kavanaugh):**

Dave is giving Kent Schilling the balance of the money for the ice time at Chill Out. He asked that Kent pressure Chill Out to fix the lighting over the ice and also outside of the door leading to the parking lot. We have to file our taxes, which we pay \$500/year to an accountant. If anyone in the club would like to do the taxes for the club, we will take money off of their player fees. We have \$38,555 in the bank along with at least \$7000 in supermarket cards. He still has a bill for socks, the banquet, and the jerseys left to pay. We will have \$23,000-\$24,000 left at the end of the year.

**Coach's Report: (Coach Jacobsen)**

**Updated Schedule**-will be sent out with a few additions. Kent has to reschedule the Roxbury game. Newton doesn't want to play WMC in the future.

**Captains Letters**-were ordered but never came in. Bill Delturrondo suggested using another vendor.

**Games at Chill Out**-It was great having the Cheer Leaders and they would like to come back again.
